Allied Boys & Girls Club Pantry (Food)

WHEN: Wednesdays 10:00am – 12:00pm and 6:00pm - 7:30pm

ELIGIBILITY: Recipients do not need to sign up in advance, but must bring ID for each family member. Anyone who lives in the 53711, 53713, or 53719 zip code is eligible to come once every four weeks.

Good Neighbors Essential Pantry (Personal Products/Household items - no food)

WHAT: Pantry has items such as: toilet paper, diapers, shampoo, deodorant, razors, band aids, toothbrushes, lotion, laundry detergent, dish soap, feminine hygiene products, etc.

ELIGIBILITY: No registration required. Pantry is available to ALL individuals and families in need. If you are at or below the federally-approved DCFS income limits, you're eligible for help from the Pantry.
